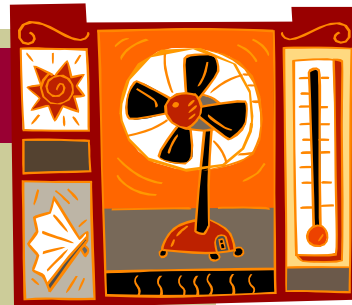

**BARBEQUE SHRIMP**

*"Finger Lickin' Good!"*

**What you need:**

Approx. 50 Shrimp (18 to 20 ct)	1 Tsp Worcestershire Sauce
2 Sticks of Butter	1 Medium Onion Sliced and Halved
1 Tbsp Louisiana Hot Sauce	5 Turns of Cracked Black Pepper
½ Cup Minced Garlic	Louisiana Cajun Blackened Seasoning

**How to make it:**

Melt butter in large pan. Add hot sauce, Worcestershire Sauce, minced garlic, cracked black pepper. Sauté approximately two (2) minutes on medium heat. Sprinkle de-headed shrimp generously with blackened seasoning. Add onions and seasoned shrimp to butter mixture. Keep stirring until all shrimp are pink, approximately two (2) minutes. After shrimp are pink, cover and remove from heat. It's great served with French bread or over pasta.
